Central N.M. Electric Cooperative, Inc. has established a fund making educational grants available to active members or immediate families of active members of CNMEC. Named the Central N.M. Electric Educational Foundation, the funds come from unclaimed patronage capital refunds of Central N.M. Electric Cooperative, Inc. Because of a legislative change in the New Mexico Escheat Law, the Cooperative is not required to forfeit unclaimed capital credits to the state provided the money is used for educational scholarships. Funds will also come from earnings on investments, voluntary donations or contributions to the trust by persons, corporations or other entities.

Who can apply? The applicant for an educational grant must be an active member or a member of the immediate family of an active member of CNMEC. The recipient must use educational grant funds to pursue an established degree from an accredited institution of higher education or vocational/technical school in New Mexico.

Application Requirements

- * The recipient must use educational grant funds to pursue an established degree from an accredited institution of higher education or vocational/technical school in New Mexico.
- * An application form, provided by the CNMEC Education Foundation must be completed.
- * For high school applicants three letters of recommendation from the high school where the applicant graduated, stating primarily that the recipient is college material and needs assistance in pursuing his/her chosen profession. If a recipient has received the equivalent of a high school degree, such as a G.E.D., then letters may be obtained from the last school attended and/or past employers.
- * An official transcript of the applicant's school records must be received with the application.
- * If the applicant is reapplying for the second year in college a copy of the current college transcript is required. No letters of recommendation are required.
- * Applicants may reapply **one time only** after receiving the scholarship the first year.
- * The application must be submitted to CNMEC **no later than January 20th** to be eligible for assistance in the fall semester of any school year.

How is the amount of the grant determined? A select committee from the Board of Trustees of CNMEC will determine the amount of educational grants per student on a per semester basis. The amount of the scholarships and the number of grants to be awarded each year will depend on the amount of money and earnings in the CNMEC Education Foundation Fund. Historically the scholarships have ranged from \$500 to \$1000 per student for one year. Scholarships are for one year and will be disbursed at the beginning of the school year.

How will recipients be selected? Persons chosen to receive educational grants will be selected based on academic accomplishments and character.
