Members enjoyed visiting with employees and participating in door prize drawings, and learning more about electrical safety through live demonstrations at our safety trailer, where linemen shared hands-on safety information with attendees.

With Quorum met, the cooperative was able to conduct official business during the meeting. Members received updates on operations, ongoing projects, and future plans. Adam Roybal shared updates from each department including progress on broadband expansion, and outlines his vision for the future of CNMEC.

Board elections were held as part of the meeting. Joe Vicente III, incumbent, will continue to serve District 3. In district 1, Rick Anaya was re-elected and will continue serving following the election, where Stuart Seagers was also a candidate.
